Cross Out or Down & Out or Shut The Box

Items needed:

Pencil

2 dice (per person if infection control an issue)

Score sheet for each person

Players needed:

2 or more

Objective: Cross out as many numbers as possible in your turn. Player with the lowest score wins.

- 1. Player one starts by rolling 2 dice. The player must cross out numbers that equal the combined total of the dice rolled. The player may cross out one number or many. Example: the player rolls a 5 and a 1, their total is 6. They may cross out the 6; the 5 and the 1; the 4 and the 2; or the 2 and the 3. Once a number has been crossed out, it can not be used again.
- After making a combination, the player rolls again and uses the remaining numbers to total the combination of the dice roll. The Player continues to do this until they can no longer make any combinations.
- 3. Any numbers that are not crossed out are totaled and put in the score section for that player.
- 4. If the player uses all of the numbers successfully, they automatically win.
- 5. Play moves to player 2 and then is repeated with the rest of players.
- 6. At the end, the lowest scoring player is the winner.
